What is Included in *Summer Sundays* RE Curriculum?

- CURRICULUM (standard 8-session version covers 7 world cultures plus the Culture of Peace; 12 session version adds a Cultural Overview, a Travel Session, another visit to the Culture of Peace, and preparation for a Multicultural Festival). The standard price includes 2 binders.
- CULTURE CAMP PASSPORTS (for twenty children)
- RUBBER STAMPS (the standard price includes 1 set)

What is the Cost?

Pricing is customized to your needs. The cost for the standard 8-session package is \$200. This includes 2 binders plus Culture Camp Passports for 20 campers, plus 1 set of rubber stamps. The 12-session version is \$300.

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Frequently Asked Questions

Q What ages are served by the *Culture Camp Summer Sundays RE Curriculum*?

A The curriculum is designed to accommodate children ranging from 5 to 12 years of age (classes can be mixed ages or broken out by age, depending on attendance) and contain sufficient material to engage children for at least an hour (or more when necessary).

Q What is the structure of the program?

A The Summer Sundays Culture Camp Curriculum is available in 2 itineraries and 2 lengths, to fit your schedule and provide a variety of destinations.

2 Itineraries:

- **World Tour I Itinerary:** *Culture of Peace, Australian Aborigine, India, Ghana, Greece, Morocco, Brazil, and Native North American*
- **World Tour II Itinerary:** *Costa Rica, Guatemala, Iraq, Japan, Romania, South Africa and Tibet*

2 Lengths:

- **8-session version** includes *Culture of Peace* and 7 world cultures (either itinerary).
- **12-session version** adds *Cultural Overview, Travel Theme, Revisiting the Culture of Peace* and a fabulous *Multicultural Celebration* at summer's end.

The program can be run either in consecutive sessions or as a Split Summer format: half the first summer and half the next summer (an

excellent format for August back-to-school introduction to the regular RE year).

Q What is the format of each session?

A Sessions are designed to be easy-to-use and self-contained. Each session features a cultural lesson, circle time, a story, an activity and a craft, as well as background information for the teacher, and information about activities, including time, goals, and materials.

Q Do you offer enrichment tools to add to the multisensory experience of cultures?

A Culture Camp Passports (and rubber stamps) are included with the curriculum. They serve as official documentation of cultures visited. In addition, classroom décor, music, banners, flags and Culture Crates containing cultural artifacts are available for rent to add to the learning experience.

Q How does Culture Camp Summer Sundays RE Curriculum teach peace thru play?

A The cultural lesson featured in each session explores an aspect of peace, whether it is respect for the earth and each other, fairness, being thankful, or the Golden Rule. The activities and crafts reinforce the lessons and give the children a chance to practice cooperation, communication, connection and conflict prevention.

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
